- Registration at Seminole Chapter Trace will be free for the rest of applicant's life (not transferable).
- Inductees become a voting member for all future MOE recipients.

3. Applicant must have at least 25 years in the Royal Ranger Ministry and be a member of the Seminole Chapter FCF or have been a member.
4. Applications must be submitted by the 1st of September of each year.
5. Application will be voted on by the MOE alumni. The District Royal Ranger Director will have the tie breaking vote and reserves the right to reject any applicant.
6. Voting dead line by November 30th of the same year.
7. Announcement and award revealed at the following Seminole Chapter Trace.
8. Each applicant accepted for induction will have their name retired, and a Medallion to be presented to them along with a certificate. Inductee's names will reside in a place of honor in the lodge at Camp Wilderness.
9. Registration at Seminole Chapter Trace will be free for the rest of applicant's life (not transferable).
10. Inductees become a voting member for all future MOE recipients.

Guidelines

1. Applicant must be a Chartered member of Royal Rangers/unless retired or living out of state.
2. Applicant must be a member of the Frontiersmen Camping Fellowship and in good standing.
3. Applicant must be a member in good standing of the church where he is attending.
4. Applicant must prove that all training levels are up to date.
5. Applicant must still have the desire to see boys and men have a true and real relationship with GOD.
